## PERTINENT FACTS CONCERNING PUPIL TRANSPORTATION

1. Transportation service shall be provided up to a distance of fifteen miles, the distance in each case being measured by the nearest available route from home to school. The statute does not require a district to provide transportation to or from a point 15 miles along the route from a pupil's home to the school legally attended where the distance is in excess of fifteen miles.
2. School districts providing transportation to a non-public school for pupils living within a specified distance from such school shall designate one or more public schools as centralized pick-up points and shall provide transportation between such points and such non-public schools for students residing in the district who live too far from such non-public schools to qualify for transportation between home and school. The district shall not be responsible for the provision of transportation for pupils between their home and such pick-up points.
3. A child who has not attained the age required for admission to the public schools is not entitled to transportation to a non-public school.
4. The statute provides for a written notice to be given to the Board of Education by the parent of a pupil attending a non-public school for whom transportation is desired, not later than April 1<sup>st</sup> preceding the beginning of the next school year, or within thirty days after establishing residence in the district.
5. The school district may provide transportation by issuing bus passes for use on "Metro Bus" providing the service is available.
