This year our Middle School Students will be required to :

- **Complete 10 hours of volunteer service**
- 5 hours must be completed by January 31st
- The remaining 5 hours are due by May 31st
- **Each service opportunity must be documented on this authorization form (one form for each service project and each signed by the coordinator of your project)**
- **You must have at least one photo of yourself completing each service activity - these photos may be printed or emailed to your teacher**
- **You must write a 10 sentence journal entry on lined paper stating where you went, why you chose this service opportunity, what exactly you did, will you continue to do this type of service in the future- why/why not?**
- The authorization form(s), the photo(s), the signatures, and the 10 sentences should be very neat and handed in, in the tray, IN A FOLDER with your name on it.

The students will be given *advanced notice in class* of upcoming service opportunities in the parish, at school, or in the community! If you have a question about a particular service opportunity, please email your teacher. If you complete your service in the summer of 2024, you must follow these directions, including signatures and pictures.

The following are some example of service opportunities:
